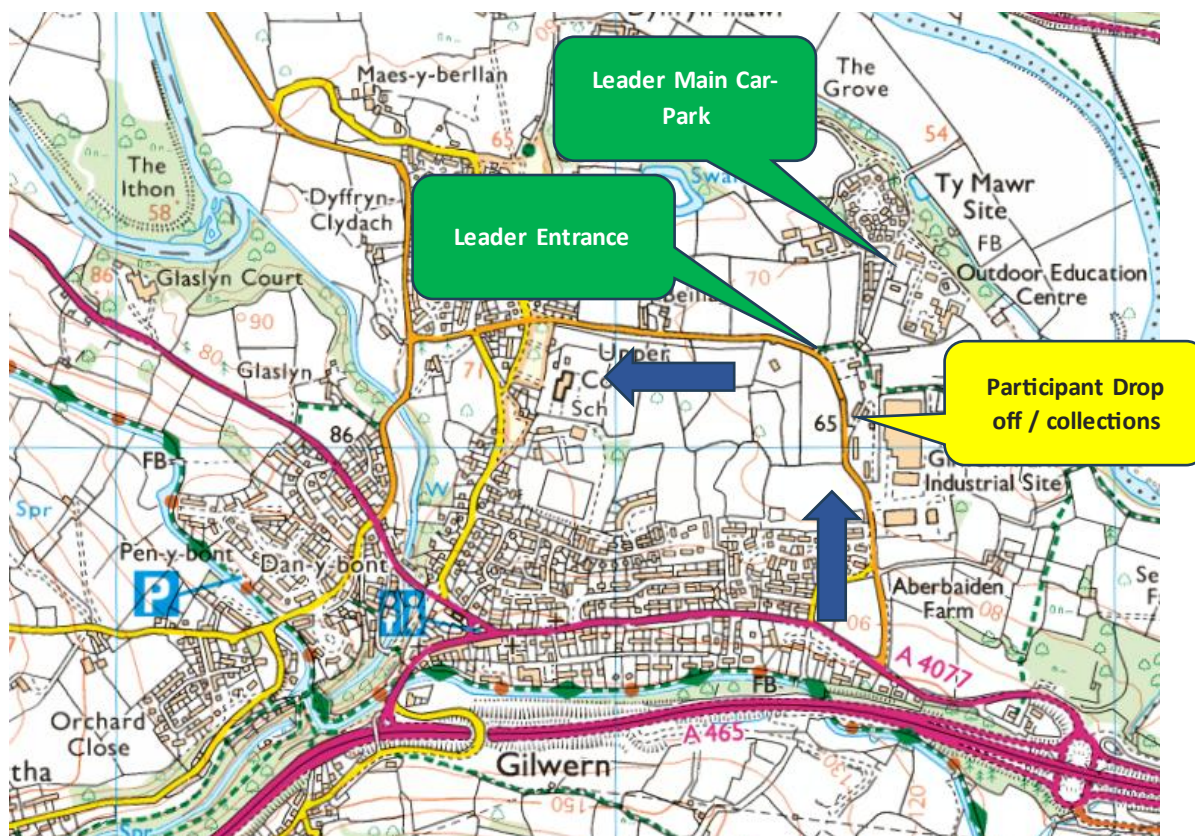


Arrival & Departure Traffic Plan

The following traffic plan should be shared with any person driving to Gwentrek 2026. It is essential everybody is briefed on the traffic plan to ensure safe arrival and departure of participants. Please note, the below refers to a dry(ish) weather plan, in event of severe weather in advance of the event, an alternative on site plan will be shared.



Arrivals / Departure

All vehicles should approach from the A4077 / A465 direction to minimise congestion in Gilwern Village

Parents / Guardians dropping off: Approach from A4077, and drive past the entrance to Matikon. Take the next right into the small industrial estate and Heads of the Valley Training Centre. On Arrival you will be directed to a dropping off point, marshals will be on hand to safely accompany young people to a holding area where they will meet with their leaders. Drivers are to remain with the vehicle and cannot enter the Gilwern site.

Parents / Guardians collection:

Due to the size of the parking area, the event is running a scheduled collection window, please aim to arrive at this time

Approach from A4077, and drive past the entrance to Matikon. Take the next right into the small industrial estate and Heads of the Valley Training Centre. On Arrival you will be directed to collection lane, please know your child's scout / explorer group, Collection Times:

- **Monmouthshire District: 1500 to 1530**
- **Newport & CRAI Districts: 1530 to 1600**

On Departure please turn right and follow the road around to Gilwern.

Leaders / Event Volunteers staying on site:

On Arrival drive past the parent / carer dropoff to entrance of Gilwern Outdoor Centre, proceed with care up the driveway, past the house and keeping on the central road. Take the right turn into the **main parking area**, once checked in you will be advised where vehicles can be unloaded and left, all leader vehicles will remain on the campsite car-park for the weekend

Leaders: Before moving your vehicle, please fill up any water containers

All equipment will need to be manually transported from the carpark to camping area (no more than 100m).

Event volunteers, you will be directed to parking areas based on role and arrival time
